General Assembly Meeting Minutes

General Assembly meeting was convened at 1900 hours.

Meeting was opened by Commander Joe Maltese. Chaplain Mike Montenaro opened with a prayer. Roll call of officers was taken and a quorum was present.

The reading of the Executive Committee minutes were waived and approved by the membership.
