Eligibility Changes – The July 2019 LEGION Act expands eligibility to all Veteran's honorably discharged from December 7, 1941 to a future date to be determined by the Federal Government. All memberships now require us to verify your service with a DD-214.

Resource Officer News

The American Legion has rebranded the Service Officer to Resource Officer. The VA added presumptive conditions for Vietnam Veterans exposed to Agent Orange.

PACT Act Expansion – VA Health Care

Beginning March 5, 2024, the VA expanded eligibility to enroll in VA health care directly without first applying for VA benefits. Any Veteran who served during the Vietnam era, Gulf War, Iraq, Afghanistan, the GWOT, or any other combat zone after 9/11 are eligible. Any Veteran NOT deployed but exposed to toxins or hazards during training or on Active Duty in the US are also eligible. Visit VA.gov/PACT or call 1-800-MYVA411 to learn more and apply for VA health care.

Retired Military Information

Retired Activities Office on NAS Jax provides assistance to the military retiree community regarding many programs and resources. Examples include VA, DFAS/pay questions, Tricare and Survivor Benefit program, as well as many others. Located in Building 13 Yorktown Avenue (across from the USO), office hours are Tuesday – Friday from 1000-1400 – no appointment needed. Call 904-542-5790 to speak with staff or leave a message.

ALL Military Retirees and their spouses are encouraged to have the new WHITE PLASTIC ID Card. This will replace the blue and beige/orange cards and are the same card stock the Active Duty use. Log into Rapids to make an appointment (priority over walk-ins) at <https://idco.dmdc.osd.mil/idco/>.

Cancelled Stamp Program: We need your cancelled stamps! Our Post participates in the Stamps for the Wounded Program for rehabilitating disabled veterans. Please bring your cancelled stamps to the next General Assembly meeting.

National Cemetery Burial Information


1. You can apply years in advance to confirm eligibility using a pre-need application. Apply online at va.gov or submit VA Form 40-10007 by mail or fax.
2. Any veteran discharged under conditions other than dishonorable qualifies for burial in a Department of Veterans Affairs national cemetery. That includes the gravesite, opening and closing of the grave, perpetual care, a government headstone and burial flag at no cost to the family.

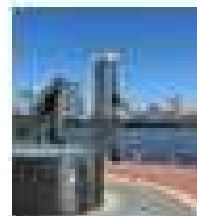
