## **Camp Lejeune Justice Act Information**

The deadline to submit a CLJA claim is coming up – **August 10, 2024**. The law firm of Bergmann & Moore was selected by the American Legion to assist members in filing claims. ## **PACT Act Expansion – VA Health Care**

Beginning March 5, 2024, the VA expanded eligibility to enroll in VA health care directly without first applying for VA benefits. Any Veteran who served during the Vietnam era, Gulf War, Iraq, Afghanistan, the GWOT, or any other combat zone after 9/11 are eligible. Any Veteran NOT deployed but exposed to toxins or hazards during training or on Active Duty in the US are also eligible. Visit [VA.gov/PACT](http://VA.gov/PACT) or call 1-800-MYVA411 to learn more and apply for VA health care.

Retired Activities Office on NAS Jax provides assistance to the military retiree community regarding many programs and resources.
