For **Vietnam Veterans**: Earlier this year, the VA added the following presumptive conditions to the exposure to Agent Orange:

Bladder Cancer

Hyperthyroidism

Parkinson's Disease/Parkinson's-like syndrome.

If you were boots on the ground in Vietnam, and you have been diagnosed with any of these conditions, then you should contact your local Veterans Service Officer and file a claim.

ALS (Lou Gehrig's disease)

If you have the following conditions, and have a current diagnosis, then a claim should be filed:

Fatigue

Insomnia

Headaches

Dizziness

Joint Pain

Respiratory problems

Indigestion

Memory problems

If you have filed a claim in the past, and have been denied then you should file an appeal. If you have never filed a claim, then a new claim should be filed. **DO NOT ATTEMPT** to file these claims online by yourself. Contact your local Veterans Service Officer.

If you have a rated condition and have not been re-rated in 5 years then it's time to file a new claim. Remember for all claims, you must have a current diagnosis for the condition you are claiming.
