Membership News

Eligibility Changes – Congress passed and the President has signed a bill on July 30, 2019 declaring the US has been in a state of war since Dec 7, 1941. The LEGION Act (Let Everyone Get Involved In Opportunities for National Service) expands eligibility to all Veteran's Honorable discharged from December 7, 1941 to a future date to be determined by the Federal Government.

Your American Legion Membership in Post 372 helps us provide needed assistance for local veteran and youth programs in our area. As you know, Post 372 does not have a physical building with a canteen in order to raise funds to support these programs. We rely on memberships, donations, and the Saturday Dinners in order to support our programs. With the COVID-19 pandemic, this is hurting our efforts on all fronts.

Even before the shutdown, our monthly Saturday fundraising dinner was poorly attended. We are making the dinner a quarterly event to hopefully boost attendance. We are very limited as to what kind of dinners that we can provide due to not having a kitchen and storage for food items. Once we are again permitted to move about, we will try the quarterly fundraising dinner again. In the meantime, maybe we can do a drive thru take out dinner where we take orders and have the dinner waiting for you.

We are approaching the time when the 2020-2021 Membership Dues will be due. If you have not paid your 2019-2020 due for the last year, please do so. As you know on your membership card it shows how many continuous years you have been an American Legion member. If you have not paid your dues for the past year and then pay for the upcoming year, this will affect your years of continuous membership. If you have friends, relatives or neighbors who served and are not members, please encourage them to join.

As noted, Congress passed a law that removes all the conflict requirements to be a member so this will open membership up to all who served. This will allow fellow veterans that you know to become members if they didn't qualify in the past, so please encourage them to join.

All memberships now require us to verify your service with a DD-214. This is due to Stolen Valor and people who were found to be members at other posts nationwide and even in leadership positions who never served in any branch of our military.

Come up to the Elks Lodge during office hours, our monthly General Assembly meetings or our dinners – once reinstated. If those times are not convenient, please email our Adjutant at Adjutant@MandarinPost372.org for assistance in paying your dues.

We have a great Sons of the American Legion Program as well. If you are a son of a veteran who served, you qualify to join our SAL.
